

Dr Clare Gapper A Cheape Piece of Magnificence: Jacobean Plasterwork in the North-West of England

To celebrate 400 years of Bishop Lloyd's Palace we are fortunate to have Clare to speak to us on Jacobean plasterers and plasterwork, with special reference to our region. She will also pointing out parallels and contrasts with plasterwork elsewhere in the country.

The setting of Bishop Lloyd's will make this a real celebration of our headquarters and its magnificent and ornate ceilings. As such, it is a perfect setting to learn about achievements in plasterwork during the English Renaissance.

Dr Gapper is an independent scholar who specialises in the history of early decorative plasterwork in Britain. In addition to her research work she has reported on plasterwork conservation for bodies such as the National Trust and English Heritage.
